





Family Reading Activities

Here are some fun things you can do to help grow your student's reading this year!



- ☐ Make a reading schedule: Set a time for reading every day and stick with it.
- ☐ Read aloud: No matter how old your student is, all readers benefit from reading aloud.
- ☐ Read what students love: Let your student find books about topics that interest them. Don't judge!
- ☐ Recommend books to each other: Share stories with topics that interest each of you.
- ☐ Quiz each other: Read a book together and write comprehension quizzes for each other.
- ☐ Rewrite the ending of a favorite book: Get creative with the characters and the plot!
- ☐ Write a story book together: Include drawings and unique characters.
- ☐ Listen to an audio book as a family: Discuss and share what you heard.
- ☐ Read a how-to book: Be sure to complete the activity together.
- ☐ Start an online book club: Connect with other students and families around reading.
- ☐ Set up a reading nook: Find a special reading spot in your home and be sure everyone knows about it.
- ☐ Plan a reading campout: Set up a tent or fort specifically meant for reading with your student indoors or outdoors. Create a sign to hang up that says, "Readers Only!"
