#### Level 1

### An offense that does not significantly disrupt the learning environment

Examples include but are not limited to:

- Inappropriate Language
  - Name calling/Insults
  - Vulgar language
  - Lying
- Inappropriate Physical Contact
  - Horseplay
  - Reactive contact
  - Public displays of affection
- **Technology Violation** 
  - Cell phone use
  - Unauthorized use of website
- Non-Compliance/Disrespect
- Transition Violation
  - Running in the hallway
  - Yelling
  - Tardiness
- Class Disruption
  - Making noises
  - -Talking without permission
  - -Work/Task refusal

### Observe Problem Behavior Is the offense Level 1, Level 2, or Level 3?

#### Level 2 An offense that significantly disrupts the learning environment

Examples include but are not limited to:

- Sustained insubordination
- Insults or vulgar language involving discrimination or taunting.
- Disruptive horseplay
- Any level 1 offense that has occured 3 times recently.

# Level 3

An offense that significantly disrupts the learning environment and possibly jeopardizes the safety of self and/or others.

Examples include but are not limited to:

- Inappropriate Physical Contact
  - Fighting
  - Sexual offenses

#### Abusive Language

- Threats of violence
- Sexual Harrassment

#### Technology Violation

- Access to explicit or inappropriate web content
- Cyber-bullying or harassment
- Accessing another students
- Weapons/Dangerous Items
- Alcohol/Tobacco/Drug possession or use
- Elopement/Skipping Class
- Theft/Forgery
- Bullying
